



Preparing 21st Century youth to appropriately move from parental dependency to self-dependence.

YEZ is a 2-part youth program conducted in schools for grades K7 through K12. It combines entrepreneurial leadership and life skills training for boys and girls.

Innately inherent within every human being is a given skill or talent. Helping youth discover the greatness within is the central focus of this program. The program is held over a period of 16 weekly 2.5 hour hands-on workshop sessions. Training begins with a 7 week essential life skills training workshop with boys and girls in separate classes. They come together collective in the entrepreneurial leadership training component.

Each segment requires completion of individual projects that engage the youth in presenting and applying the concepts learned. In addition to the 16 week class study, youth participants are required to complete a 20-hour volunteer work internship.

Parental approval for enrollment is required. In addition, parents of youth who enroll are required to attend the initial orientation, participate in at least 2 parenting education workshops, and attend 1 life skills session with their child and 1 entrepreneurial workshop session with their child as arranged with the parent.
